Seven good reasons to become an active member of INAISE

1. Participation in a historic global network

The INAISE network is the only global network dedicated to social and solidarity finance and brings together pioneers and prime movers in the sector. Becoming an INAISE member is therefore to integrate your organisation in the family of social and solidarity finance actors. The network includes all stakeholders who agree with its Charter and thereby support sustainable development, the social and solidarity economy as well as rural development. These stakeholders are rich in geographical diversity and constitute a diverse range of organisational types.

2. Mutualising the skills of social and solidarity finance

Through workshops, annual conferences, and its working groups, the INAISE network enables its members to increase their knowledge and skills in the field, by exchanging best practice, sharing their experiences, learning from structures and projects existing around the world, developing their contact networks, and participating in collaborative initiatives. Members of INAISE receive ready access to the network's extensive database of contacts in other member organisations and expert bodies in the social and solidarity finance sector.

3. Supporting the Development of social and solidarity finance

INAISE membership not only identifies your organisation as a strong and committed actor in the sector, but also helps improve the visibility of the sector around the world and assist in promoting finance that sustains the real economy by enabling the network to develop a stronger voice in informing national and international policies towards social and solidarity finance.

4. Sharing in and coownership of strategic and organizational decisions

The INAISE network encourages all members to participate in its working groups, in its decision-making process in its Annual General Meetings and to contribute to its governance via the Board of Directors, and in so doing shape a strong future for the network.

5. Participating in the INAISE information flow

The network is most effective when members share news and information. In INAISE there is a two-way flow of information.

And documents can be shared in the Members only facility on the website.

INAISE regularly posts updates on the website and on its Facebook page. Member organisations automatically receive INAISE publications such as our quarterly newsletter which contains important information about INAISE, developments in the sector and the activities of other INAISE members.

6. Fee-free participation in the Annual Conferences of INAISE

The Annual Conference of INAISE is a very popular event and attracts hundreds of social and solidarity finance actors. The conference is organized around a relevant theme and hosted by a different member organisation each year. Each organisation is entitled to one free delegate at the conference.

7. Use of the INAISE logo to support your credibility and increase your visibility

As the global network of the social and solidarity finance, displaying the INAISE logo in your publications and web presence represents a strong acknowledgment of your organisations' status as an investor in the social and solidarity economy on a world-wide platform.
